Term:

 Membership is recommended by the Chair of Liaison Committee and approved by the President for a term of 2 years.

Meeting Schedule:

• The Committee will meet as needed.

Secretariat:

- The secretariat for the Committee will be provided by the University Community, Child & Youth Services Division.
- Agendas and relevant materials will be circulated before the meetings, and meeting minutes will be prepared and circulated for review by the Committee.
